Jax REcycle partners with non-profits to provide bicycles to individuals who need transportation to get to work or school. Organized by volunteers, Jax REcycle takes donations of used and discarded bicycles and facilitates workshops to repair and refurbish the bicycles. Once the bikes are in safe working order, they are placed with non-profit partners whose clients are in need. Since 2008, Jax REcycle has repaired and placed over 300 bicycles with adults who need them to get to work. With each bicycle, the owner receives a helmet for safety, a lock for security, and training about general bicycle maintenance.
